

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Your entry is deemed to include
acceptance of these rules

To be run in accordance with PC Eventing Rules 2012
(available from www.pcuk.org).

1. Eligibility applies to the day of competition
2. Entries will be taken in strict order of receipt but branches are limited to 8 entries per class, **with priority given to Area 13 Branches** and then a wait list will be started. It is unlikely that we can accommodate any second horses.
3. Entry fees will not be refunded without a doctor's or vet's certificate which must be received no later than 7 days after the event.
4. The decision of the judges is final. No video evidence will be considered.
5. Objections to be lodged with the secretary in writing within thirty minutes of the incident, together with a £10 deposit which will only be refunded if the objection is upheld
6. The organisers reserve the right to alter the timing of the phases and to retain £5 per entry in case of cancellation
7. **ALL HATS TO BE WORN IN THE COMPETITION MUST BE CHECKED AS BEING TAGGED BY THE SECRETARY BEFORE A NUMBER WILL BE ISSUED.** Hats shall conform to Pony Club 2011 standards and must have chinstraps fastened at all times when mounted. Body protectors and medical armbands are compulsory for the XC Phase. In the interests of safety the organisers reserve the right to eliminate any competitor in breach of this rule.
8. No entries will be taken by telephone, by email or without an entry fee
9. On the day of the competition horse may only be ridden by their competitor rider
10. DOGS must be kept on a non-extending lead at all times. A fine of £50 will be charged to the owner of any dog found off the lead
11. Bad language is deemed to be unseemly behaviour and will incur elimination
12. Neither the organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury, illness or any mishap that may occur to horse, rider spectator or any other persons or property whatsoever.
13. **If you are eliminated in the Show Jumping you will NOT be allowed to go Cross Country**
